



The Wines of Austria & Hungary

DAY ONE: Welcome to Vienna, a beautiful city filled with history, art and, of course, music. DAY TEN: It’s off to Tokaj-Hegyalja to sample Hungary’s most sought-after sweet wine, Tokaj (Tokay). This wine is known as the nectar of Kings and is even mentioned in the Hungarian national anthem. This day will linger in your memories for years to come. You will also experience the charming culture, friendly people and delicious cuisine. Consider a bowl of hearty Hungarian Goulash. The spicy enviting dish is endeared by all.

DAY ELEVEN: Start this morning with a transfer to Budapest where you can enjoy the rest of the day at your leisure. This evening, you will be special guests at a Hungarian folklore dinner show. Sleep well.... For tomorrow starts your flight home.
